can replace 1 ton of heavy oil (costs US\$430), a saving of US\$260 per ton of production cost. Moreover, coal water mixture is an energy source causing lower pollution and this improves environmental protection.

4. Prof. Chen Min – Unpolluted Biological Azotobacter Fertilizer  
Time: 1645hr – 1655hr

Professor Chen Min has remarkable achievement in the research of Biological Azotobacter Fertilizer. Biological Azotobacter Fertilizer can increase agricultural productivity (5% - 50%), improve the quality and market value of agricultural products, reduce the use of chemical fertilizer (30% - 50%), protect the agricultural ecosystem, increase the organic content in the land, and generally brings larger income to farmers.

5. Dr. Dinh Duc Huu – Nuclear Power: Safe and Clean Energy Resource  
Time: 1655hr – 1705hr

Dr. Dinh Duc Huu is the first Asian to be authorized by the US National Atomic Energy Agency to manage a nuclear power plant in Louisiana, USA. According to him, we will not have another power more abundant, cost-saving and environment-friendly than nuclear power within the next 200 years. It is very safe and clean compared to other types of energy resources. It is therefore important to have nuclear power plants to achieve energy balance and ensure energy security for long-term socio-economic development.

6. Prof. Ou Yong Jian – The Special Features of the China Financial Market  
Time: 1705hr – 1715hr

Professor Ou Yong Jian is a research fellow of Institute of Social Sciences in Guangzhou. He is also the Secretary-General of Association of Village/Town Heads in Guangdong Province.
